

Assess Freelancers

Features

Independent employees carry out their work under their own responsibility, possibly through their own limited company. The work is carried out in accordance with the registration with the Chamber of Commerce and the job description.

Company documents

- Chamber of Commerce extract or equivalent (NL not older than 1 year or automatic verification)
- (Model) agreement signed by both parties
- Preferably liability / third-party insurance

Details

For sole proprietorships with staff, the rules for subcontractors or employment agencies apply.

Additional information/documents for self-employed worker from EU/EEA

- Name, nationality, date of birth
- The [BSN](#) (Dutch Social Security Number) must be held by the freelancer, but does not need to be requested because GDPR rules.
- For establishments outside the Netherlands but within the EU/EEA: A1 form and registration on [postedworkers.nl](#) of the person

Additional documents for self-employed person not from the EU/EEA

- Copy of Valid passport (please check Nationality on worklocation before entering)
- Residence permit plus Work Permit or Combined Residence and Work Permit (please check the back of the document carefully)
- The [BSN](#) (Dutch Social Security Number) must be in the possession of the self-employed person but does not need to be requested

Special attention

- Inquire about a registration with the Chamber of Commerce abroad; sometimes this is a one-off declaration of self-employment by a government agency.
- A self-employed person hired by another self-employed person must be registered separately and cannot piggyback on the contracting party
